ACCESS & VICTORY PLACE

ACCESS provides food, shelter, warmth and other essential services to low income children, families, seniors, Veterans and people with disabilities in Jackson County.

Victory Place, the 17-unit affordable Veterans' housing complex developed by ACCESS, was made possible from a \$1.96 million grant that the Oregon Housing and Community Services awarded to ACCESS. That grant has empowered the organization to provide housing assistance to Veterans.

ACCESS helped write the grant proposal and was responsible for overseeing the development and construction Victory Place. The property and development are privately-owned by Fred Herrmann of Commercial Counsel Inc. As part of the grant, Hermann guarantees that the project will be affordable for renters for 60 years.

EMERGENCY HOUSING ASSISTANCE

Leveraging funds allows SSVF programs to provide temporary housing for eligible literally homeless participants who are awaiting permanent housing when no other shelter is available.

GENERAL HOUSING STABILITY ASSISTANCE

General Housing Stability Assistance covers costs that include (but are not limited) to car repairs, driver's license fees, tools related to maintaining employment, basic kitchen supplies, beds, baby food, and fees for rental applications.

COLLABORATION

United Community Action Network (UCAN) and Oregon Coast Community Action (ORCCA) are subgrantees helping to serve Veteran families in Coos, Curry, Josephine and Douglas Counties.

\$6,500,000

Approximately \$6,500,00 has been spent on Veterans and Veteran families in our community since 2015.

GRANT EXPENDITURES

The grants also cover personnel costs, temporary financial assistance for Veterans and Veteran families, outreach, administrative and non-personnel costs.
